



"Gustavo Sclocchi" Theses Awards 2004

for Philosophy Doctors, University and Diploma Graduates
with Degree in Petroleum Engineering and Geo-Sciences

1. In order to encourage and reward university and diploma graduates who specialise in petroleum engineering and geo-sciences, the SPE (Society of Petroleum Engineers - Italian Section), the EAGE (European Association of Geoscientists & Engineers) and Assomineraria (Associazione Mineraria Italiana - Hydrocarbon and Geothermal Sector) are glad to announce the 12th Theses Award.
2. All university and diploma graduates from Italian universities and Italians graduating abroad, who are completing their courses between October 1st 2003 and October 31th 2004, are entitled to submit their work for the award. The award is also extended to PhD who have completed their research thesis in the same period.
3. The theses must cover subjects related to Hydrocarbon and Geothermal Exploration & Production activities:

**Geology, Geophysics and Formation Evaluation
Wells Drilling and Completion
Reservoirs Engineering
Production and Transport
Health, Safety and Environment**

4. Candidates must submit the following documents with the indicated deadlines:

An abstract of the thesis, in English, two pages max – deadline October 1st
A complete copy of the thesis – deadline October 31st
A document attesting the date and place of graduation – before the Award Ceremony

It must be noted that Abstracts have significant impact on the evaluation process, so that a careful and accurate writing contributes to the thesis appreciation.

The Board of Directors of the SPE Italian Section, the EAGE Board and the Board of Directors of Assomineraria jointly appoint the Evaluation Committee, which is composed of experts in the above disciplines. The Evaluation Committee shall select a maximum of eight theses considered to be the most worthy of receiving the Award. Their decision is final and not subject to appeal.
6. **Each winner will receive a prize of € 1,500 (Euro one thousand five hundred).** Moreover, a mention of each award-winning thesis will be published in the «SPE Bulletin» of the Italian Section, in the «EAGE First Break» and in the «Assomin Bulletin». The Award ceremony will take place in December 2004.
