Francesco Guidi received a degree in engineering from the University of Rome.

After working as a reporter, he first joined the press-office and subsequently the technical areas of ENI.

He spent 20 years abroad, primarily in Africa. At first he was head of a seismic group and later became supervisor in Italy, Egypt, Iran, Abu Dhabi and then head of AGIP Exploration and Production in Tanzania, Nigeria, Egypt and Libya.

His lecture analyzes the hydrocarbon upstream sector in the world but is also an overview of the political and economical development of producing countries, from OPEC (1960) to the present.

He will attempt to explain the increase of crude oil prices and make forecasts.
